Training & support:

Regular supervision sessions with supervisor. Opportunity to attend NSPCC events. Opportunities to take part in training and volunteer days in order to promote personal development and competencies.

Day/times:

Varied and flexible - agreed on an individual basis between volunteers and supervisor, dependant upon the activities that the potential volunteer is interested in.

- Assists with the facilitation / development of any of the varied sports activities and training which are offered by the NSPCC, either based at the Centre e.g. Boys Football, Mini Soccer Skills, Multi-Sports etc., or as part of the out reach work of the team delivering sports activities to local schools or events during school holiday times either on school grounds or recreation grounds.
- Option to become involved with the management committee of Participation Through Sport to help develop and evaluate the sports programmes offered to young people from the NSPCC service.
